Phagyab Rinpoche is a Tibetan lama from Kham, Eastern Tibet. Educated in India, he was recognized as the reincarnation of the Phagyab Rinpoche by His Holiness the Dalai Lama in the 1990's and requested to return to Tibet. Upon his return, he taught Buddhism widely and was eventually apprehended for his open support of Buddhism, non-violence and the Dalai Lama. Imprisoned and tortured for several months, he escaped to India and emigrated to the US in 2003. A monk, scholar, and highly renowned practitioner in the Gelugpa order of Tibetan Buddhism, Phagyab Rinpoche regularly calls for forgiveness and kindness to those who perpetrate violence on others.
